2017 K-12 Engineer Volunteer of the Year

The Florida Engineering Society K-12 Committee, in conjunction with the Florida Engineering Foundation, will award \$500 to a Florida Engineering Society member who has volunteered his/her time to introduce engineering and technology concepts and activities to K-12 students. \$500 will also be awarded to the volunteer's local FES Chapter for its use in furthering the local K-12 effort.

Who May be Nominated:

1. Any current FES member who has actively promoted engineering and technology concepts to K-12 students.
2. FES Member must be nominated by a local chapter of the Florida Engineering Society.

Process:

For an FES member to be considered for the award, the FES volunteer and local FES Chapter must complete and submit the following by May 12:

1. Personal information resume (maximum of two pages) for the volunteer
 - a. Name, home address, home telephone and email address
 - b. Professional and community activities
 - c. Information on volunteering efforts that support the K-12 mission
2. Letter of support from the local FES chapter (maximum of two pages, double spaced), to include the answer to the following:

How has this FES member contributed to the FES K-12 mission to introduce K-12 students to engineering concepts and principles?

The letter should include specific examples of engineering and technology presentations and activities in which the volunteer has participated.
3. Letter of support from teacher(s) with whom volunteer has worked.

A cash award will be presented to the winning FES member volunteer and the FES chapter by representatives of the FES K-12 Committee at the Florida Engineering Society's Annual Conference in August. The selection committee will consist of the FES K-12 Committee Chairperson, three members of the FES K-12 Committee, and FES K-12 Committee Staff Liaison.
